

This is a qualifying tournament to determine the top ten teams to qualify for the Alabama State FCA Golf Scramble. Each team member may hit every shot. Team members decide which shot they prefer to play. All players may hit from that location only. This procedure is repeated until the ball is holed out.

1. USGA stroke rules govern all competition, except for local rules of play and those regarding the scramble format.

2. Each team member may place his/her ball within one club length of the selected shot, no nearer to the hole. If the selected shot is played from a hazard, bunker, rough, second cut of rough, fairway or fringe of the green, the ball may be placed within one club length of the selected shot, no nearer to the hole, but must remain in the hazard, bunker, rough, second cut of the rough, fairway or fringe of the green.

3. A team member may improve his lie, placing the ball by hand or by moving it with his club head.

4. When putting, the ball must be placed within two inches of the selected shot, no nearer to the hole. Teams are cautioned not to make tap-ins until all members have had the opportunity to make the team's original putt. Once the ball is holed out, no further strokes are permitted.

5. Team members may stand behind one another to help determine the line of a shot or putt.

6. Methods for breaking ties will be determined by matching score cards.

7. Men will hit from the white tees. Men (60 and over) and all women may hit from the Senior tee box.

8. The teams with the lowest gross score and lowest net score will have \$600 applied to their State Tournament entry fee. Other qualifying teams will be invited to the State Tournament.
